## Getting to the Windward Islands

## An important read for all parents of students headed to the Advanced Adventure Voyages in St. Lucia, St. Vincent & the Grenadines, and Grenada.

Travel this summer is going to be a privilege, and we should be accepting and open during the end of this pandemic.

For Advanced Adventure S.E.A. Voyages in the Windward Islands, these are one-way voyages. The first voyage goes south bound and the second north bound. The north island is Saint Lucia (airport code UVF) and the south island is Grenada (airport code GND).

We suggest The Moorings Travel Service (from North America) but you are not required to use them. They may be reached at 800.535.7289, or **Soun Saysonvang**, our Air Agent, her direct number is **866.649.2003**. Leave her a message if she is unavailable and she will return your call.

Due to the changing COVID-19 travel requirements we do not suggest making travel arrangements for the 2022 voyages yet. Travel protocols and Airline schedules are changing. We will update this page in Spring 2022 with then current travel plans.

- Voyage 1 South bound
  - o Starts in Saint Lucia (UVF) June 23rd
  - Ends in Grenada (GND) July 13th
- Voyage 2 North bound
  - Starts in Grenada (GND) July 14th
  - Ends in Saint Lucia (UVF) Aug 3rd

## Land Transfers:

- Transfers between the marina and the Grenada's are not included (approx \$10).
- Transfers between the marina and St Lucia's airport are not included (approx \$30).
- An Odyssey Expeditions staff member will meet all arriving shipmates at the respective airports and assist with the transfer.
